

2014 J.C. Raulston Arboretum Irrigation Project

With a desperate need for watering risers throughout the Arboretum, the CIA chose to install a watering system for a 2014 Community Project.



Volunteers and contributors from Ditch Witch, John Deere Landscapes, Atlantic Irrigation, and Simmons Irrigation, the riser project was completed without a hitch. Many thanks go out to the CIA Directors who supervised and worked this project. They were Erich Kolb, Will Koster, and Jim Garvey.



Most of the digging and installation was done with a full day on the 22nd and with final install on the 23rd.

With over 900 feet of 2-inch pipe and fittings, quick coupler valves, a trencher, swing arms, and wire, the job took two days to complete.
